RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING MELTEN VAN DUYN

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this city suffered a great loss in the passing of Melten Van Duyn on the 11th day of December at the age of 81 in Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, Melten Van Duyn came to the U.S. from Holland at age 21, settling in San Francisco, and later moving to Sacramento; and
