SUMMARY

This Agency has recently hired Brenton A. Bleier to fill the position of Chief Counsel which has been vacant as a result of Richard H. Hyde's entry into private practice. This report recommends that the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento retain Richard at a much reduced fee to complete legal work on certain projects which were well along prior to Mr. Bleier's arrival.

BACKGROUND

Some current Agency projects have sufficient complexity and duration that a change of legal counsel could have an adverse effect on their speedy and advantageous completion. Richard Hyde has worked on these projects since their inception and should be retained for these specific projects.

The activities for which Mr. Hyde should be retained are:

1. Hotel project at 12th & L Streets;
2. Study of Old Sacramento contractual obligations for parking;
3. Legal analysis of federal and local capital improvement requirements;

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4. Miscellaneous final detail work on projects where legal work is essentially completed such as PERS, UDAG-Liberty House and amendment of Central City Redevelopment Plan.

Mr. Hyde is now under contract to the Agency for legal work involving the projects listed above.

FINANCIAL DATA

The recently completed contract with Mr. Hyde was written on a billable time basis with a maximum of \$34,000. The proposed contract calls for a rate of \$65.00 per hour with a maximum of \$18,500. The source of funding for the contract would be individual cost codes for each specific project.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento approve the attached resolution authorizing the Executive Director to contract with Mr. Richard H. Hyde for legal services. This proposal has been developed jointly with Mac Mailes.
