AMENDMENT

Leave of Absence Rules

After general discussion by members

of the Board, the following amendment

to Rule VIII of the Civil Service

Board Rules and Regulations with reference to the granting of leaves of absence

was introduced, ordered posted and action postponed until next regular meeting

of the Board:

RULE VIII - LEAVE OF ABSENCE

SECTION 1 - ELIGIBILITY: No leave of absence shall be granted with-
in six months after appointment or reinstatement or to any employee
holding a position with the City under temporary appointment.

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SECTION 1.1 - DURATION - THREE MONTHS: Leaves of absence may be granted by the head of a department upon approval of the City Manager for a period not to exceed three (3) months during any elapsed period of one year. The request for said leave shall be submitted to the City Manager for approval before the commencement of said leave and shall definitely state the period of time and the reason for which said leave is requested. After approval by the head of the department and the City Manager, said request shall be filed with the Civil Service Board.

SECTION 1.2 - DURATION - ONE YEAR: If at the end of a three months leave, conditions are such as to warrant an extension of the leave, the Civil Service Board may, at the request of the employee and upon recommendation of the department head, approve an extension of said leave for a period not to exceed one year including the original leave and extension.

SECTION 1.3 - DURATION - OVER ONE YEAR: Leaves of absence for military service or for sickness of a nature, which in the opinion of the Board justifies a leave of a period longer than one year, may be granted by the Board, provided that sick leave without pay may be terminated when in the judgment of the Civil Service Board its further continuance would be detrimental to the service. Applications for extended leaves of absence for sickness must be accompanied by a signed statement from the employee's personal physician.

SECTION 1.4 - EXPIRATION OF LEAVE: Failure to report for duty after a leave of absence has expired or has been disapproved, or revoked or cancelled by the appointing power or the Civil Service Board, shall be considered a separation from service, unless the employee so separated shall show to the satisfaction of the appointing power or Civil Service Board that such failure to report was excusable, in which case the Civil Service Board may order the reinstatement of the employee with the consent of the appointing power. The failure of an employee to return to duty at the expiration of a leave of absence without pay shall be deemed a resignation.

SECTION 1.5 - EFFECT ON POSITION: Upon the expiration of a leave of absence, an absentee may be reinstated in his former position; provided, however, if such absence exceeds thirty (30) days or in case of sickness ninety (90) days, and the position in the meantime has been filled, the name of said employee shall be placed on the reinstatement list and when a vacancy exists in said classification, the employee may receive appointment to said vacancy in order of his seniority.

SECTION 1.6 - TIME OFF: Appointing powers may give permission to employees to be absent for personal reasons, without pay, not to exceed an aggregate of five (5) working days in any one calendar month. Such "time off" shall be considered as entirely distinct from vacations or other leaves of absence provided for in these rules and shall not require the approval of the Board but shall be reported in writing as a matter of record.

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After further discussion by members of the Board with reference to future policy in the granting of leaves of absence, Mr. Deise moved nothing contained in the present leave of absence rules or the foregoing amendment shall be held to establish any right on the part of employees for leaves of absence for the purpose of engaging in other business or qualifying themselves to do so; seconded by Mr. Root and motion carried.

AMENDMENTS
RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following amendments to Rules III, IV and V of the Civil Service Rules and Regulations having been posted for

a period of one week in accordance with Section 4 Rule X were finally considered:

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RULE III, SECTION 15 APPEAL FOR REVIEWING: Any applicant may appeal to the Civil Service Board to have his examination papers reviewed on the ground of errors committed therein, if said appeal is made in writing within ten (10) days after receiving announcement of the result of the examination. Upon a review of the examination papers of the applicant, his rating may be changed, in accordance with such review. If, in the judgment of the Board, such review discloses errors on the part of the examiners affecting the examination papers of all applicants, then all the examination papers may be reviewed.

RULE IV, SECTION 4 ELIGIBLE LISTS - DATE EFFECTIVE AND LIMITATION: Eligible lists shall become effective upon the date set by the Board for the posting, thereof, and shall expire by limitation of time in two (2) years from that date, unless extended or cancelled prior to the expiration of said two (2) year period by order of the Board.

When an eligible register is abolished, eligibles unable to accept employment or continue employment because of military service during a period of national emergency, may have their names placed on the top of the new eligible register if their names have been reached in certifications to permanent or to temporary positions, if they so request and submit their honorable discharge papers within 90 days after release from military service. Those eligibles whose names were not reached by certification, and who were unable to take the new examination because of military service, may have their names placed on the new eligible register at their old percentage, if they so request and submit their honorable discharge papers within 90 days after release from military service.

RULE V, SECTION 6 - REMOVAL OF TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES: Within thirty (30) days from the posting of an eligible list in any position, the appointing power must terminate the services of such persons as may be temporarily employed therein, and if the position is to be filled, it must be filled upon requisition and certification from the eligible list referred to herein within the time set forth. The Board shall not approve the salary claim of any person for services rendered in conflict with the provisions of this section.

Mr. Root moved that the foregoing amendments be approved; seconded by Mr.

Marty and motion carried.
