California Creative Corps Administering Organization Grant

BACKGROUND

- A. The California Creative Corps Program is a \$60 million one-time General Fund allocation for the California Arts Council (CAC) to implement a media, outreach, and engagement campaign designed to increase: (1) public health awareness messages to stop the spread of COVID-19; (2) public awareness related to water and energy conservation, climate mitigation, and emergency preparedness, relief, and recovery; (3) civic engagement, including election participation; and (4) social justice and community engagement.
- B. The City of Sacramento's Office of Arts and Culture (OAC) was selected by the CAC to receive the highest award amount for a single organization for the California Creative Corps Program Administering Organization grant in the amount of \$4,750,000.
- C. OAC will work with its regional partners in Sacramento, Yolo, El Dorado, Alpine, and Solano counties to redistribute grants to artists collectives, nonprofit social service/civic organizations, arts nonprofits, units of local government, and tribal governments for creative campaigns.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to accept the grant award from the CAC in the amount not-to-exceed \$4,750,000.

SECTION 2.

The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement and secure payment.

SECTION 3.

The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to establish the California Creative Corps Program grant (G17610000), and related revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount not-to-exceed \$4,750,000 (Fund 2702 Operating Grants) to implement the award.
