

HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL,

CITY OF SACRAMENTO,

DECEMBER 27th, 1921.

At Call of the Chair, The Honorable City Council assembled in Special Session on this date at hour of 10:47 o'clock A. M., Mayor Elkus presiding.

Roll Call was answered by following members of the Council:

Anderson, Bidwell, Brown, Elkus, Funke, Kiernan, Lindley, Sullivan, Wilder.

The Mayor thereupon announced the appointment of a City Clerk, the purpose which called the Council together at this time, was fraught with no small degree of deep sorrow, and that the sudden passing from this life of Michael J. Desmond on December 25, 1921; one who had so faithfully and efficiently served as City Clerk for twenty-six years, had cast a cloud of much sadness over the entire community.

With consent of the Council, the Mayor then appointed Councilman Bidwell as Clerk pro tem, the latter moving that all arrangements for the attendance of the Council at the funeral services and matters incident thereto be referred to the Mayor with power to act. Seconded by Councilman Kiernan and carried by following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Anderson, Bidwell, Brown, Elkus, Funke, Kiernan, Lindley, Sullivan, Wilder.

Mayor Elkus appointed the following as Committee on Resolutions:

Councilwoman Lindley and Councilmen Bidwell and Sullivan.

The matter of appointment of City Clerk was taken up, and on motion by Councilman Bidwell, seconded by Councilman Brown, F. W. Grider was placed in nomination for the office.

There being no further nominations, roll call on the appointment of F. W. Grider as City Clerk of the City of Sacramento resulted as follows:

Ayes: Councilmen Anderson, Bidwell, Brown, Elkus, Funke, Kiernan, Lindley, Sullivan, Wilder.

Oath of office of F. W. Grider as City Clerk was ordered filed.

Councilman Brown moved that official bond in sum of \$10,000 with Hartford Accident & Indemnity Company as surety and bearing approval endorsement of City Attorney, presented by F. W. Grider as City Clerk, be approved and ordered filed. Seconded by Councilwoman Lindley and carried by following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Anderson, Bidwell, Brown, Elkus, Funke, Kiernan, Lindley, Sullivan, Wilder.

F. W. Grider thereupon returned thanks to the Council for their action in his appointment and made the following appointments, which were ordered made of record; viz,

Personal Secretary to City Clerk, Paul H. Manby,
Record Clerk and Book Machine Operator, Harry G. Denton, whose oaths of office

were presented and ordered filed.

Councilman Anderson moved that Council adjourn out of respect to the memory of Michael J. Desmond. Seconded by Councilman Wilder and carried by following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Anderson, Bidwell, Brown, Elkus, Funke, Kiernan, Lindley, Sullivan, Wilder, and thereupon at hour of 11 o'clock A. M. Council adjourned out of respect to the memory of the late, M. J. Desmond, former City Clerk of the City of Sacramento.
