SUMMARY

Subject:

This report recommends the transfer of funds to complete Senior Citizens Center Expansion and Remodel (KA62). Additionally, it is recommended that Capital Improvement Projects KA51 and LC41 be cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Senior Citizens Center Expansion and Remodel project is designed to expand the facility by an additional 5,721 square feet to include an assembly room, kitchen, both mens' and womens' restrooms, and supporting staff rooms. The project will also replace the existing heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system with energy efficient equipment. The project EIR and plans and specifications will be presented for acceptance before full Council on May 16, 1989.

Capital project KA51 (Johnston Pool Safety Fencing) was originally designed to replace the existing chainlink fence. The Parks and Community Services Department staff have determined that the proper security fencing should be wrought iron fence, approximate cost \$95,000. The existing fence has been repaired and is acceptable until the design, plans and funding can be arranged for a permanent replacement.

Capital project LC41 (Miller Yard Pesticide Storage). This project was established and funded to comply with CAL OSHA requirements for storage of toxic pesticide containers. Due to the proposed change in functional use of the Miller Yard, the Parks and Community Services Department staff has configured the City's nursery to house these containers. The nursery is properly secured and meets all Cal OSHA requirements.

FINANCIAL

The estimated cost of the Senior Citizens Center Expansion and Remodel is \$817,215 of which \$701,266 is in the current budget for the project (\$450,000 Capital Grant and \$251,266 General Fund). Facility Management will allocate \$95,000 from the operational budget for the replacement of the HVAC system in the existing building. CIP KA51 (Johnston Pool Safety Fencing) has an unobligated balance of \$11,786 that will be transferred. LC41 (Miller Yard Pesticide Storage) has an unobligated balance of \$9,179 that will be transferred. This brings the total to \$817,231. With these transfers, sufficient funds will be available to cover the cost of the project.

RECOMMENDATION

It is requested that the Budget and Finance Committee approve and forward to the full City Council the attached Resolution authorizing:
