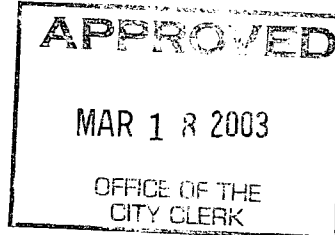

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING ON A PORTION OF TRACTION
AND ALTOS AVENUES**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Traction and Altos Avenues between El Camino and Eleanor Avenues. Council District 2.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to prohibit all parking on Traction and Altos Avenues between El Camino and Eleanor Avenues.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends prohibiting all parking on portions of Traction and Altos Avenues (Exhibit A). Prohibiting all parking adjacent to the bike trail will contribute to the revitalization of the area and discourage loitering.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- A Triangle Park Task Force has been formed to address problems in the community bordered generally by Del Paso Boulevard, El Camino, Eleanor and Altos Avenues.
- The task force requested that the City remove all parking along Altos and Traction Avenues, adjacent to the bike trail.
- The area adjacent to the bike trail has ongoing problems with loitering, auto repair on the public right-of-way and other code violations.
- Removing all parking will contribute to the revitalization of the area and discourage objectionable behavior.
- This proposal is supported by the Triangle Task Force, the Police Department and the Area Director.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$800 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhood Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City's Strategic Plan and the goal of the City Council to enhance and preserve the neighborhoods.

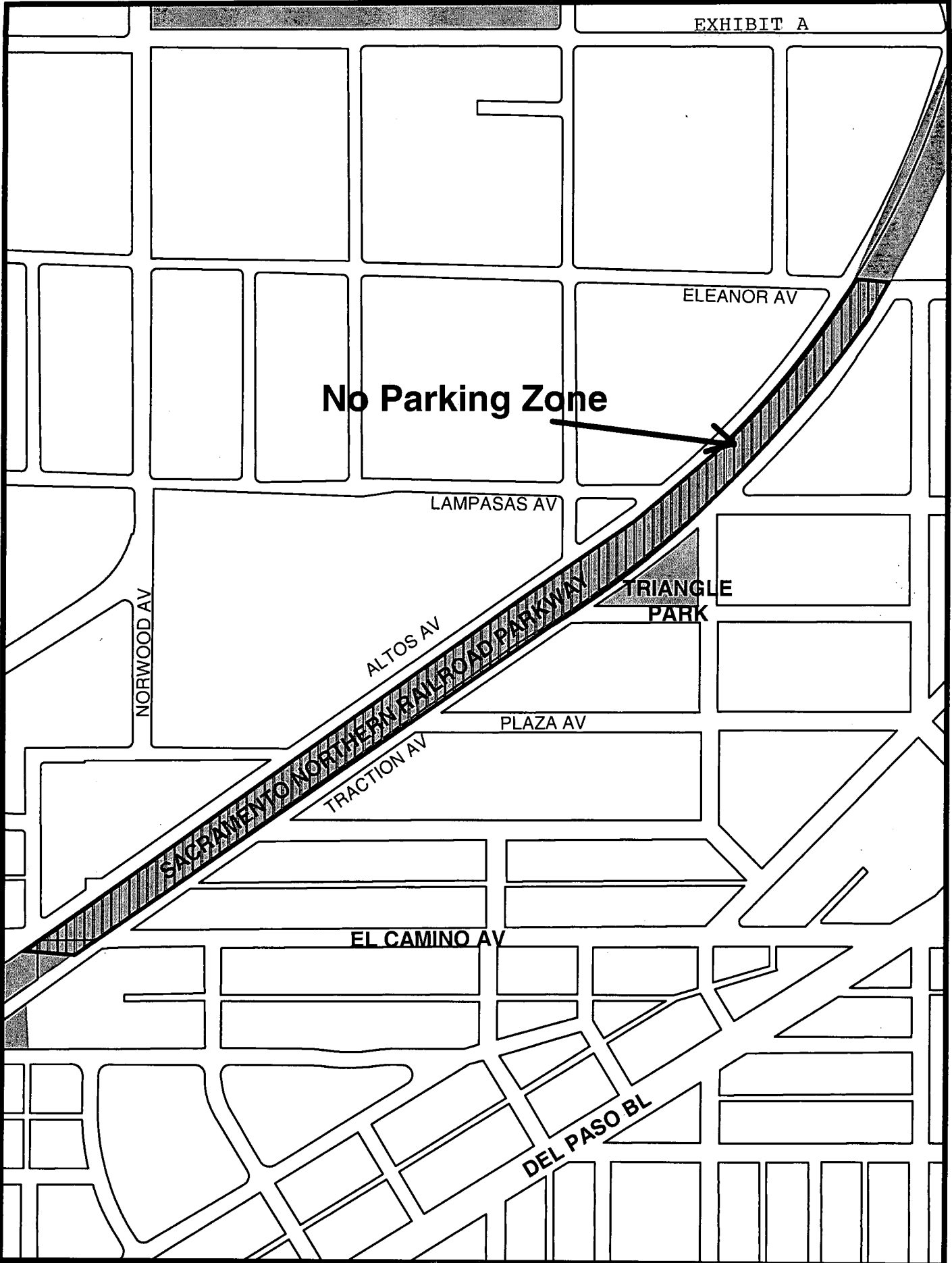

**A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING
ON PORTIONS OF TRACTION AND ALTOS AVENUES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.36.020 of the Sacramento City Code, when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

All parking shall be prohibited on the following streets:

- Altos Avenue, south side, from El Camino to Eleanor Avenues.
- Traction Avenue, north side from El Camino to Eleanor Avenues.
