RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING CARL COPE

IT IS HEREBY noted that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Carl Cope on the 5th day of July, 1980, at the age of 55, in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Carl Cope, was co-owner of the Firehouse Restaurant for more than 20 years; and

WHEREAS, he was a former of the Sacramento Junior Chamber of Commerce and the 20 - 30 Club, an original member of the Eaglet Theater, and was the first mayor of Old Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes, and the official records of the City, record the passing of CARL COPE, and has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which this meeting shall be called adjourned in respect to the memory of CARL COPE.
