

ORDINANCE NO. 440, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1st, 1921, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A new Section is hereby added to Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, adopted September 22, 1921 to be numbered and shall read as follows:

Section 52 $\frac{1}{2}$. FUEL DEALERS. For every person, firm or corporation conducting, managing or carrying on the business of selling, offering for sale, exposing for sale, vending, delivering, furnishing or dealing in wood, coal, blocks or any other material to be used or utilized for fuel purposes, \$100.00 per year, payable in advance, and for each and every person, firm or corporation conducting or managing more than one place of business a like sum for each additional place of business.


The provisions of this Section shall not apply to any person, firm or corporation, who directly delivers wood, blocks or other material to be used or utilized for fuel purposes, the same being the product of his own land, provided, that said land is not leased or rented for the purpose of cutting and marketing the fuel thereon.

The license herein provided for shall be for a period of one year of twelve months, dating from the day of issuance of the license or from the date of expiration of the next preceding license to such applicant. Under no circumstances shall the license fee or any portion thereof be remitted or refunded.


Provided, that none of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed or construed to include the sale, vending or delivering of gas and oil or any of its by-products.
