SUBJECT: Approval of Consultant Services Agreement with Engineering Computer Corporation for Preparation of Improvement Plans for the Rio Linda Boulevard Street Widening Project and Terminating Existing Agreement with Terra Engineering

SUMMARY:

It is recommended that the subject agreement with Engineering Computer Corporation be approved for the design of the Rio Linda Boulevard Street Improvement project between Arcade Boulevard and Silvano Street. It is also recommended that the existing agreement with Terra Engineering be terminated.

BACKGROUND:

On February 13, 1979, the City of Sacramento entered into an agreement with Terra Engineering in the amount of \$62,000.00 to provide consultant engineering services for the subject project by passing City Council Resolution 79-079. Preliminary design work was performed in 1979 and early 1980 in order to provide information for subsequent environmental impact studies required by the State of California and the Federal Government for this Federal Aid Urban project. Approval of the environmental document was given by the Federal Highway Administration on March 28, 1984. The project includes widening Rio Linda Boulevard to four lanes within the above reach and constructing curbs, gutters and sidewalks. A new bridge is to be built over Arcade Creek.

In October of 1982, Terra Engineering went out of business and the staff joined with that of Raymond Vail and Associates. We have subsequently discussed the project in detail with Raymond Vail and Associates and Engineering Computer Corporation (ECC). ECC, who was originally a subcontractor to Terra Engineering, completed the preliminary design and was to provide final design services for the bridge over Arcade Creek, a significant portion of the subject project. Based on these discussions and a review of proposals from the two firms, it is recommended that the consultant selection procedure be waived and an agreement be executed with Engineering Computer Corporation for completion of the project design.

FINANCIAL:

The subject agreement is for an amount not to exceed \$71,314.00. As of April 27, 1984, \$145,000.00 has been budgeted for the subject project and \$87,369.37 is remaining in the project cost center (C.C. 1066). Terra Engineering was paid \$20,654.50 of the amount included in the original agreement.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the subject agreement with Engineering Computer Corporation be approved and that the existing agreement with Terra Engineering be terminated by passage of the attached Resolutions.
