

ORDINANCE NO. 488, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCURE EQUIPMENT AND TO DO THE GRADING AND OTHER NECESSARY WORK AT THE SACRAMENTO AIR PORT WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase, in open market, the materials, and to procure the equipment and to employ the necessary services and labor, expert - skilled or unskilled, to do, on the Sacramento City Airport, the necessary grading and other work, including surface and subsoil drainage, surfacing of runway, field lighting, fencing, water supply and road work at an estimated cost of \$5,000.00, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of beginning the work at once so that as much as possible thereof be done before the rainy season.
