

ORDINANCE NO. 530, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A DIVISION OF WATER IN THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT; PRESCRIBING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a Division of Water in the Engineering Department which shall be in charge of the construction, management, supervision, maintenance, extension, operation and control of all water supply and distribution to the City and its inhabitants.

SECTION 2. There shall be a Superintendent of this Division appointed by the City Manager.

SECTION 3. The City Manager shall appoint one of the deputies in the office of the City Controller to be the cashier or equivalent officer in said division.

A financial report in detail shall be made to the Council quarterly.

SECTION 4. Receipts from said division shall be paid into the City Treasury and maintained in a separate fund. Appropriations from such fund shall be made for the following purposes, in the order named, viz: (a) for the payment of all operating expenses; (b) for pension charges and proportionate payments to such compensation and other insurance and accident reserve funds as the Council may establish; (c) for repairs and maintenance; (d) for depreciation; (e) for the payment of interest and sinking funds on the bonds issued for acquisition, construction or extensions; (f) for extensions and improvements; (g) for a surplus fund; (h) and for such other purposes as may be found necessary in connection with the furnishing of an adequate and suitable water supply for the City of Sacramento.

SECTION 5. If any accumulation in the surplus fund of this division shall, in any fiscal year, exceed 25% of the total expenditures of such division for operation, repairs and maintenance for the preceding fiscal year, such excess may be transferred by the Council to the general fund of the City.


SECTION 6. Ruls and regulations for the supply and use of water and water rates shall, by ordinance, be fixed from time to time by the Council upon recommendation of the City Manager.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
