SUMMARY

Resolution authorizing the sale of Fire Station No. 17 to the Redevelopment Agency. Adoption of the Resolution is recommended.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 23rd, 1982, the Council approved by a motion the sale of Fire Station No. 17 to Redevelopment Agency at the appraised value of \$71,100.00. The Redevelopment Agency has the funds to purchase said property and is ready to conclude the transaction.

FINANCIAL DATA

The proceeds from the sale are to be deposited in a special fund, 7-96-0000-3701, as directed by the Council for use in the construction of Fire Station No. 11, Florin Road and Havenside Drive.

That the City Manager and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Grant Deed to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento for the following described parcel:

The North 157 \$60 feet of the following described parcel: The tract of land designated as "Park" lying Easterly of the Northern Electric Railroad Company holding, Westerly of Rose Street, Southerly of Grand Avenue and Northerly of Orange Avenue, now known as Roanoke Avenue in Del Paso Heights, according to the official plat thereof, filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County on February 7, 1911 in Book 12 of Maps, Map No. 1.
