REPORT BACK ON REPAYMENT OF COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY IN SUPPORT OF

**SAFCA** 

#### SUMMARY

This report presents the estimated cumulative costs incurred by the City through June 30, 1991 in support of the Office of Flood Control Planning and the Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency (SAFCA) and the projected repayment of those costs. The estimated total to be repaid is \$1,225,971. Of this amount \$238,591 has been budgeted for repayment in FY 1991-92 and \$942,380 is expected to be repaid in FY 1992-93. This report was requested by the City Council in special session on June 5, 1991.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Office of Flood Control Planning (OFCP) became operational in March 1989. The Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency succeeded the OFCP in January 1990 under a joint agreement with the County of Sacramento and other agencies. It was agreed that the City would be reimbursed for costs incurred in support of OFCP and SAFCA operations when funds from SAFCA's permanent financing mechanism became available. Attachment 1 summarizes the estimated total costs through June 30, 1991 and the preliminary schedule for repayment. The repayments scheduled do not include the repayment of \$10,000,000 advanced from Certificate Of Participation (COP) bonds. SAFCA has paid \$568,305 in interest on the COP funds in fiscal year 1990-91 and will pay \$719,000 in fiscal year 1991-92, which are separate from the amounts computed for repayment. SAFCA agreed to repay the bond advance in full in fiscal year 1993-94.
