SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

## BACKGROUND

This project will remove and replace deteriorated sewer mains in three (3) locations (as listed above) in the downtown area.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on October 18, 1988. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$298.500.

#### FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost. including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$380,200. The current budget is \$410,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Sewer Fund (414). The funds available for this project amount to \$389,000, as of April 10, 1989.

A non-refundable fee of \$15\$ will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.
