LOCATION: The portion of Pocket Canal Parkway between Greenhaven Drive and Swan River Court.

SUMMARY

The work on the Paving of the Bike Trail at the Pocket Canal Parkway project was completed on October 15, 1991 at a cost of \$88,778.52 and project acceptance is recommended.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Accept the project;
2. Authorize the filing of the Notice of Completion and Acceptance of Work with the County Recorder; and
3. Authorize final payment.

BACKGROUND

Teichert Construction of Sacramento has completed Project No. HA71, Council Contract No. CO91-031, dated July 30, 1991. This project provided for the construction of an asphalt concrete bike trail along the Pocket Canal between Greenhaven Drive and Swan River Court.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

As of November 18, 1991 this project had a balance of \$221,216 from the Transportation Development Fund (235) and the Quimby Act Fund (710), which is sufficient to close this contract.
