IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Warren C. Williamson on the 15th day of April at the age of 39 in Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, Warren C. Williamson was a well-known and respected member of the Sacramento community whose exemplary efforts and accomplishments were of great value to the citizens and the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, Warren C. Williamson was a land surveyor who donated his professional services for many projects in the Greenhaven/Pocket area and was chairman of the citizen's group for development of Seymour Park, one of the projects to which he donated volunteer labor; and

WHEREAS, Warren C. Williamson served as a director of the South Pocket/Greenhaven Residents for Neighborhood Schools, and was honored for his work on behalf of Measure B, which resulted in the building of Lisbon and Martin Luther King schools; and

WHEREAS, Warren C. Williamson was a veteran of the United States Army, a member of the California Association of Land Surveyors and vice president of the Greenhaven Soccer League; and

WHEREAS, Warren C. Williamson was an exceptional person who touched the lives of many and who will be deeply missed by all who came to know him; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Warren C. Williamson and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Warren C. Williamson.
