

ORDINANCE NO. 704, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 304, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 12 1926, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAVEL, TRAFFIC AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES LAID OUT FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; DEFINING THE TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE; CREATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 80, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 22ND, 1922, AND ALL ORDINANCE AMENDATORY THEREOF." BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBERED 31-1, AND REPEALING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 694, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MARCH 5 1936.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:  
PARKING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

*Sec 31-1*  
SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive upon or across or to leave standing or cause or permit to be left standing any vehicle upon any privately owned property in the City of Sacramento without the consent of the owner thereof.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 694, Fourth Series, passed March 5 1936, is hereby repealed.
