SUBJECT: 65th Street Expressway Traffic Signal Coordination (PN:SB76) - Fund Transfer and Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bid. Bids have been received and additional funds are needed. Transfer of funds and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The project will interconnect the traffic signals along 65th Street from Folsom Boulevard to Elder Creek Road to improve the flow of traffic along that arterial. The pedestrian walk lights will be upgraded to improve pedestrian safety at the intersections.

On November 28, 1989, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on December 19, 1989. The bids received were:

May-Han Electric, Inc. dba M & M Electric	\$109,945.84
Community Electric, Inc.	\$174,567.50
Steiny and Company, Inc.	\$201,398.75

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$161,000. The estimated project completion date is June 15, 1990.

FINANCIAL DATA

Additional funds are needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$174,000. The current budget is \$150,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Major Street Construction Funds (209).

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65th Street Expressway Traffic Signal Coordination (PN:SB76) -
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The funds currently available for this project amount to \$109,000 as of February 6, 1990. It is proposed that the needed amount of \$24,000 be transferred from Miscellaneous Minor Improvements/Traffic Signal Maintenance project (PN:SB46), Major Street Construction Funds (209) which has a balance of \$130,730 as of February 6, 1990.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

None.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were ten (10) plan holders for this project, none of whom are certified MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the transfer of funds by adoption of the attached resolution, accept the low bid of May-Han Electric, Inc. dba M & M Electric in the amount of \$109,945.84 and award the contract.
