SUBJECT: STATE DEPARTMENT OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS GRANT FOR \$110,000

Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign the agreement for the Sacramento Fire Department to receive a \$110,000 grant from the State of California Department of Toxic Substances Control for the purchase of Hazardous Materials Response equipment for regional training facility.

SUMMARY:

The Sacramento Fire Department has been selected by the California State Department of Toxic Substances Control to receive a \$110,000 equipment grant to be used for the Hazardous Materials Certified Training Course equipment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control has authorized the Sacramento Fire Department to administer a \$110,000 grant for the purchase of equipment to be used solely for Hazardous Materials Training. This is part of the development of regional Hazardous Materials Training for O.E.S. Region IV. The only requirement of the grant is that the Department limit the use of the equipment to

training. This grant will enable the Department to purchase valuable training tools including breathing apparatus, instrumentation and protective suits, which will greatly enhance our HazMat Training program.

The cost of the equipment to be purchased, up to \$110,000, will be reimbursed to the City by the Department of Toxic Substances Control.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

Approval of this agreement by the City Council will enhance the Sacramento Fire Department's ability to provide Emergency Hazardous Materials response training.


