SUMMARY

This report recommends that Council award the contract for Fire Station No. 9 to Zenith Construction Company for apparatus door replacement.

BACKGROUND

Due to extensive amount of annual repair work on apparatus doors at Fire Stations No. 6, 3301 Sacramento Blvd.; 9, 5801 Florin-Perkins Road; and 12, 4500 24th Street, and the emergency nature of these facilities, it was decided to replace the doors and install emergency signals to avoid the accidental impact of fire trucks to these doors. The replacement of the apparatus doors at Fire Station Nos. 6 (1986) and 12 (1988) has been completed. Zenith Construction provided, properly performed and completed the work for Fire Station No. 12.

Replacement of the apparatus doors at Fire Station No. 9 will complete the work originally intended by the designated C.I.P.

Since the recently completed work at Fire Station No. 12 is identical to that required at Fire Station No. 9 and because Fire Station No. 9 is currently experiencing operational problems with their doors, Zenith Construction has again been contacted. Because the bid amount of Fire Station No. 12 was the result of competitive bidding, award of a new contract to Zenith Construction for the same construction services at the same contract amount should be representative of a competitive low bid and enable replacement work at Fire Station No. 9 to begin immediately.


FINANCIAL DATA
