- APPOINTMENT:** Twelve (12) members recommended by District 8, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, including representatives from each of the following seven categories:
- A. Resident property owners;
 - B. Non-resident property owners;
 - C. Tenants or renters;
 - D. Community based organizations;
 - E. Business owners/managers;
 - F. Meadowview resident high school student;
 - G. One non-voting member designated by the Sacramento City Unified School District
- TERM:** Two (2) years. Two term limit applies.
- MEETINGS:** Monthly, on the first Thursday
- COMPENSATION:** \$50 per meeting attended, not to exceed \$150 per month
- POWERS & DUTIES:** To encourage citizen participation in the Meadowview Area and to provide community forums to propose and review community goals and objectives. It is an advisory body to Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission, SHRA, and the City Council on policy matters within the Agency's control that affect the Meadowview Area. The Committee is authorized to:
- 1. Review and comment upon proposed Agency funded activities and assist in the formulation of projects and programs to meet identified goals and objectives, including housing programs.
 - 2. Comment upon the implementation of community development plans and programs.
 - 3. Take under consideration such other matters as from time to time the City Council, or the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission, or Agency deem appropriate.
