A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR F.Y. 1980/81 FOR THE RICHLAND STREET ASSESSMENT DISTRICT (BETWEEN 66TH AND 71ST STREET, SOUTH OF FRUITRIDGE)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- 1. The work has been completed for the Richland Street Assessment District (Between 66th and 71st Street, South of Fruitridge) and additional funds are necessary to cover the City's share of the project.
- 2. The City Budget for Fiscal Year 1980/81 is hereby amended by appropriating \$20,058.89 from the unappropriated General Revenue Sharing fund balance (2-11) to the City Engineer's Budget (2-11-2600-1022-4820) for the purpose stated in Paragraph 1 above.

SUBJECT: Richland Street Assessment District (Between 66th and 71st

Street, South of Fruitridge)

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that additional funding in the amount of \$20,058.89 be approved for the subject project and that staff be directed to forward the attached resolution to Council for adoption.

FINANCIAL:

In July 1979, the City Council approved the appropriation of \$403,000.00 for the City's share of the Richland Street Assessment District. has been completed and the final project cost is \$576,170.40, including engineering and incidental bond costs. As part of the approval, the City guaranteed the cost to the property owners to be \$20.00 per front foot. Based on this guarantee, the property owners will pay \$154,250.83 leaving the City's contribution to be \$421,191.63. Funds currently remaining in this project are \$401,132.74 leaving a deficit of \$20,058.89. Staff recommends that additional funds be appropriated from the General Revenue Sharing fund balance to cover this deficit. The assessment district is not in a CDBG area; therefore, CDBG funds can not be used.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve the appropriation of \$20,058.89 of General Revenue Sharing funds for this project and direct staff to forward the attached resolution to Council for adoption.
