SUBJECT: Suspension of Formal Competitive Bidding for the Purchase of  
Nine (9) Each 20 Cubic Yard Rear Loading Truck Mounted Refuse  
Compactors

SUMMARY

The Equipment Maintenance Division has a requirement for the purchase of nine (9) each 20 cubic yard rear loading truck mounted refuse compactors identical to the ones awarded by the City Council to International Harvester on June 17, 1980, (Purchase Order Number 47842). Since International Harvester is offering to supply nine additional vehicles at the same unit price (\$47,745.30 plus sales tax), it is recommended that the City Council suspend formal competitive bidding for this requirement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The following is a bid tabulation of the four bids received on May 20, 1980 (bids were mailed to eighteen potential vendors known to furnish similar types of vehicles):


FINANCIAL DATA

RECOMMENDATION


