ORDINANCE NO. 2217 FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ANNEXATION OF
CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY COMMONLY
KNOWN AS "BASLER PROPERTY."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Sacramento did heretofore receive a petition in writing for the annexation to the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation, of certain uninhabited territory lying contiguous to said city, signed by the owners of not less than one-fourth of the assessed value of the territory described herein according to the last preceding equalized assessment roll of Sacramento County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, the City Council duly and regularly fixed a time and place for hearing of protests to said annexation for July 28, 1960, at 7:45 p.m., in the Council Chamber of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall, 9th and I Streets, Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, a copy of said resolution and notice fixing the time and place for hearing of protests were regularly published in the "SACRAMENTO UNION," a newspaper of general circulation, and the official newspaper of the City, at least twice, but not oftener than once a week, and the publication of which was completed at least 20 days prior to the date set for hearing. And further, that said resolution and notice of hearing of protests were published in the "NORTH SACRAMENTO JOURNAL," a newspaper of general circulation, published outside of the City, but in the county, at least twice, but not oftener than once a week, and the publication of which was completed at least 20 days prior to the date of said hearing; and further, that the City Clerk sent copies of said notice to each person to whom land within the territory proposed to be annexed was assessed at the last equalized county assessment roll, properly addressed to the person known on said assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was held in accordance with the notice and the Council finds that protests were not filed by owners amounting to one-half of the value of the territory as shown by the last equalized assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of the City of Sacramento that said uninhabited contiguous territory be annexed to the City of Sacramento,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

That that certain uninhabited contiguous territory situated in the County of Sacramento, State of California, and more particularly described and bounded as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the southerly boundary line of the right-of-way of north G Street with the center line of the right-of-way of North 16th Street; thence from said point of beginning generally ~~southerly~~ ^{northerly} along the center line of the right of way of North 16th Street to the southeast corner of the City Limits line of the City of Sacramento as described in Sacramento City Ordinance No. 2173, said corner being the intersection of the center line of the right of way of North 16th Street with the center line of the right of way of Vine Street; thence generally northerly along the City Limits line of said City of Sacramento and along the center line of the right of way of North 16th Street and the center line of the right of way of the Roseville Freeway to the intersection of the center line of said Freeway right of way with the meandering center line of the American River, said intersection being the northeast corner of the City Limits of said City of Sacramento as described in said Sacramento City Ordinance No. 2173; thence generally upstream along the meandering center line of said American River to its intersection with the northerly production of the center line of the right of way of North 18th Street; thence generally southerly along said northerly production and the center line of the right of way of North 18th Street to a point located northerly 1639.90 feet, more or less, from the intersection of the center line of the right of way of North 18th Street with the center line of the right of way of North B Street; thence generally westerly 802.10 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

be annexed to the City of Sacramento, and said City Council does hereby approve such annexation.

SECTION 2.

That the territory above-described and commonly known as "BASLER PROPERTY" will not be required to pay its pro rata share of bonded indebtedness of the City, previously authorized prior to annexation thereof.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall be published once in the "SACRAMENTO UNION," a newspaper of general circulation, published in the City of Sacramento and the official newspaper of said City, and shall take effect 30 days from and after its passage.
