**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING
EVERETT GLENN**

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Everett Glenn on the ninth day of April, 1982, at the age of seventy-nine, in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Everett Glenn served as City Attorney from 1946 to 1965, advising the Council and staff during a time of rapid growth and change in Sacramento; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Glenn was considered to be a patient and fair man who was dedicated to his work and who consistently turned out quality work in the most challenging circumstances; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Glenn was known as a fine gentleman and a true friend, whose pride in his hometown manifested itself through a variety of civic and community activities; and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Everett Glenn, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Everett Glenn.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to Elizabeth Glenn, bereaved widow, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
