SUBJECT: RESOLUTION MODIFYING PARKING REGULATIONS ON A PORTION OF F STREET IN THE ALKALI FLATS RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA.

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

F Street from 12th to 13th Streets. Council District 1

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution modifying parking regulations on F Street between 12th and 13th Streets from one-hour parking from 8am to 10pm except with "F" permit to two-hour parking from 8am to 6pm Monday through Friday except with "F" permit.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends modifying the parking regulations on a portion of F Street. Modifying the parking regulations from one-hour from 8am to 10pm parking except with "F" permit to two-hour parking from 8am to 6pm Monday through Friday except with "F" permit will be more convenient for resident because their guests will be allowed to park longer and at night and on weekends without permits.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- In anticipation of increased parking congestion from area events and the construction of a new City parking garage, parking regulations in the Mansion Flats neighborhood (E to G, 12th to 16th Streets) of the Alkali Flats residential permit parking area were modified in June of last year.
- There were some residents opposed to the extended parking regulations.
- Residents on a portion of F Street have petitioned to reverse the existing parking regulations to the original limitations (two-hour permit parking except weekends and holidays).
- A letter which outlined the proposal and solicited comments was sent to the residents and property owners that will be impacted by the change.
- Most residents supported the proposed change.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking modification is \$400 for the modification of the existing signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:


This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.



**RESOLUTION MODIFYING PARKING REGULATIONS ON A PORTION OF
F STREET IN THE ALKALI FLATS RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.48.190 of the Sacramento City Code, on-street parking regulations within a residential permit parking area may be changed by resolution of the City Council based on recommendation by the Parking Manager

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The on-street parking regulations in the Alkali Flat residential permit parking area shall be modified as follows:

Modify the one-hour parking time limit from 8am to 10pm except with "F" permit to two-hour parking from 8am to 6pm Monday through Friday except with "F" permit on the following street segment:

- F Street, both sides, from 12th to 13th Streets.
