SUBJECT: Underground Fire Alarm - Franklin Boulevard (PN:TD91) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is a portion of the Franklin Boulevard Street Improvement Assessment District which will improve Franklin Boulevard from Sutterville Road to Fruitridge Road. This phase of the overall project will remove the aerial fire alarm cable and install new cable in an underground conduit along the east side of Franklin Boulevard. Placing the fire alarm cable underground will be coordinated with the Sacramento Municipal Utility District project to place their electrical lines in underground conduit.

On May 1, 1990, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on May 22, 1990. The bids received were:

May-Han Electric, Inc., dba M & M Electric	\$84,469
Grason Electric Co.	\$96,876

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$79,000. The estimated project completion date is October 1, 1990.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total cost of this phase of the project, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$107,000. The current total project budget is \$810,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program with \$100,000 from Measure A Sales Tax funds (201), \$420,000 from Major Street Construction funds (209) and \$290,000 from Capital Grants funds (248).

The funds available for this project amount to \$724,000, as of May 29, 1990.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City Code concerning the award of contracts.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were four (4) planholders for this project, none of whom are certified MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of May-Han Electric, Inc. dba M & M Electric in the amount of \$84,469, and award the contract.

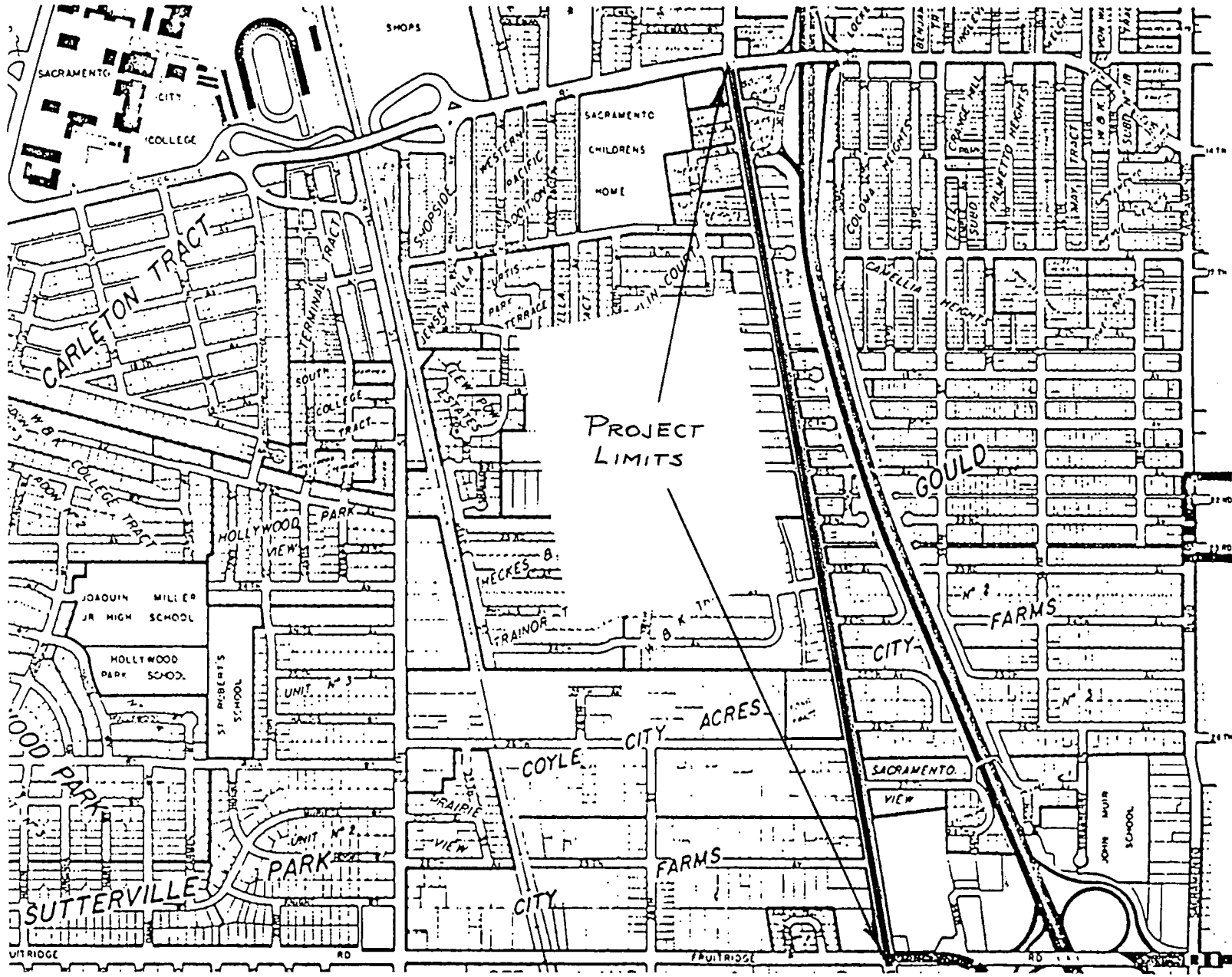
