

SPECIAL MEETING
SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL
OCTOBER 22, 1958

The Honorable City Council met in special session on this date at hour of 4:05 o'clock P.M., Mayor Azevedo presiding and roll call was answered as follows:

Councilmen Azevedo, Culjis, Lobner, Marty, McKinney, Sayre, Seymour, Shelby and Wood.

Executed copies of the call issued by the Mayor and presented by the City Clerk were ordered filed.

The call stated the purpose of the meeting to be that of considering the question of inclusion of schools districts in the proposed "Hagginwood Annexation Area" in to the Sacramento City Unified School District and to present such other matters as may regularly come before said body or be presented by the City Manager.

Dr. Drayton B. Nuttall, Chief of School District Organization for State Education Department, presented a report containing an analysis of the possible extra cost to the Sacramento Unified School District resulting from the annexation of the Gardenland-Del Paso Heights-Hagginwood Area.

Foregoing report was read and ordered placed on file.

Mr. John E. Mogan, 2049 Dry Creek Road, Del Paso Heights, addressed the Council stating that the schools in the proposed annexation area should be included in the Sacramento City Unified School District if said area is annexed to the City of Sacramento.

Mr. John Merrifield, 1200 E Street, Rio Linda, stated that the majority of the people in his area were opposed to joining the City of Sacramento.

Mr. Ted Hodel, 6133 West Fourth Street, Rio Linda, addressed the Council and stated that body should hear from officials of the school district.

Mr. James Harris, Supervisor of State Finance Department's Fiscal Section, addressed the Council and verbally answered questions relating to the City's liability in connection with outstanding state loans incurred by the district, etc.

Mr. T. R. Smedberg, County Superintendent of Schools, addressed the Council and discussed the effect of breaking up school attendance areas by annexation.

Mr. F. Melvyn Lawson, Deputy Superintendent of City Schools, addressed the Council and stated that the Board has taken the position that it favors annexation to the City Unified School District any area annexed to the City.

Councilman Lobner addressed the Council and moved the inclusion on the ballot, a proposal to annex the schools to the City Unified School District. Seconded by Councilman Wood.

Councilmen McKinney and Sayre requested a one day delay on the motion in order to permit residents of the areas proposed for annexation to be heard.

After discussion, Councilman Shelby moved that foregoing motion be tabled. Seconded by Councilman Seymour and carried by the following roll call:
