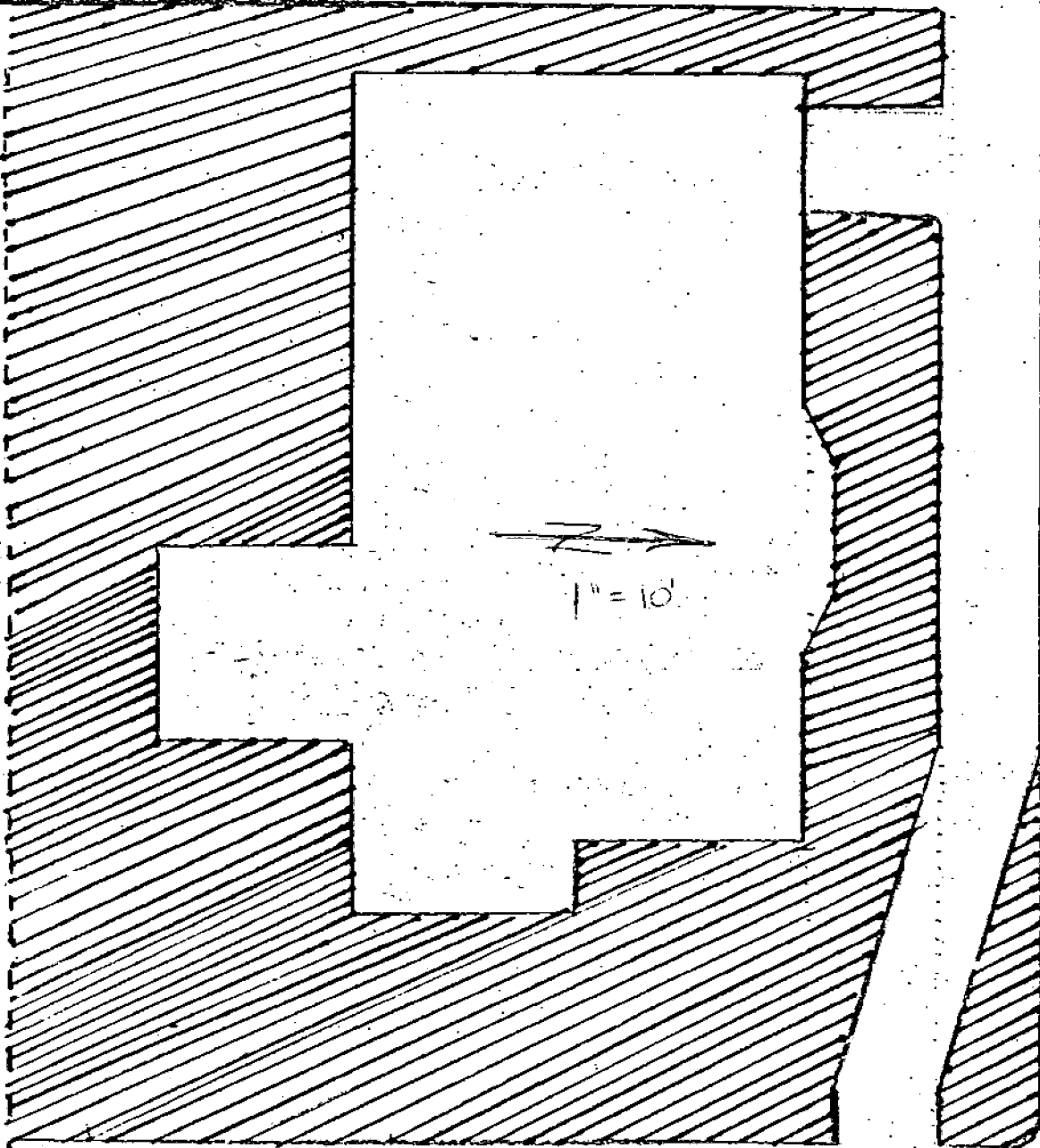
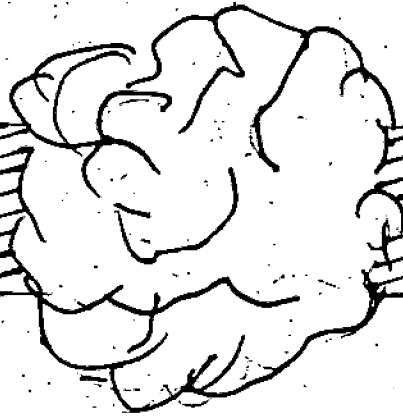
1. Provision 21 "Liability Insurance" is hereby waived.
