SUBJECT: Reconstruction of Basketball Court at Tahoe Park (PN:LE21) - Project

Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will reconstruct the existing basketball court at Tahoe Park, which is a junior sized court and is badly deteriorated. The reconstructed court will be a full size basketball court.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on April 11, 1989. The landscape architect's estimated construction cost is \$17,700.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$26,600. The current budget is \$30,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the General fund (101). The funds available for this project amount to \$24,700.

A non-refundable fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

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POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

None.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Specifications will be sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on August 15, 1989.
