RESOLUTION APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

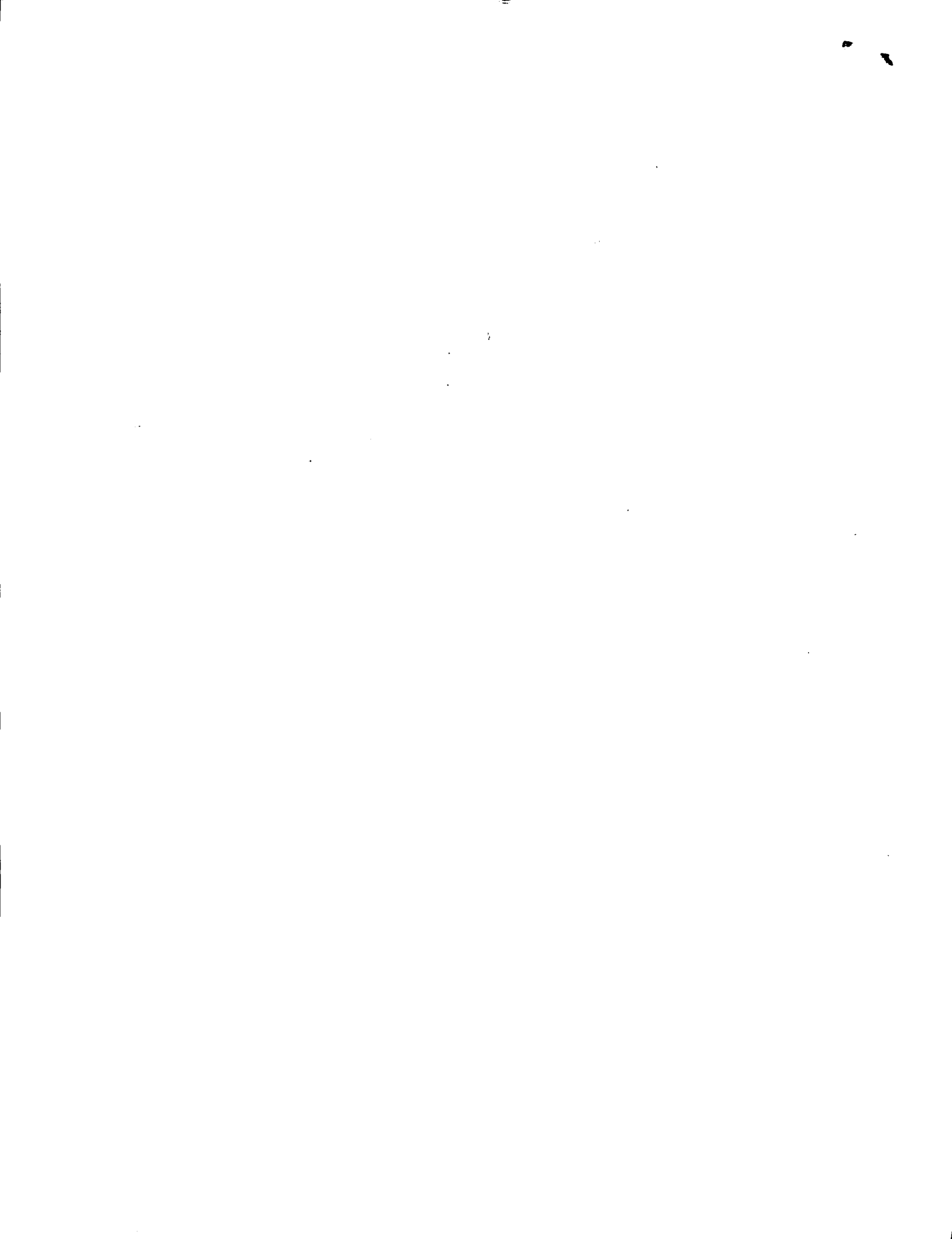
In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the paving of the bike trail at Pocket Canal Parkway project would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On January 17, 1991, the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. A Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in a local newspaper. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

The portion of Pocket Canal Parkway between Greenhaven Drive and Swan River Court is currently landscaped with a gravel service road. The proposed project will pave portions of the existing gravel service road.
