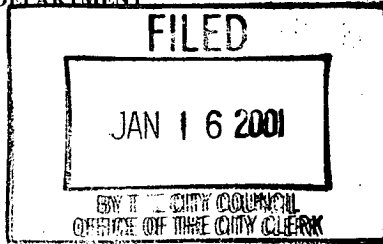

SUMMARY:

This report is for City Council information only and outlines the agenda for the Joint Sacramento/West Sacramento City Council Meeting on January 23, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. at the City of Sacramento City Council Chambers, 915 "T" Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

BACKGROUND:

The Cities of West Sacramento and Sacramento have agreed to hold a joint City Council meeting each year to address items of mutual interest. The meeting on January 23, 2001 will be the third joint meeting between the two cities. The cities have agreed to alternate the meeting site and this year the meeting will be in Sacramento.

Representatives from both cities have met and agreed the format for this year's meeting will consist of three types of topics:

- 1) Action Items (Items that require an action by the two cities).
- 2) Status Reports (A verbal status report on items or projects that are in progress and of mutual interest to both cities).




