SUBJECT: Guy West Bridge Suspender Replacement (PN:HA51) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will replace the deteriorated suspender cables that run from the overhead suspension cables to the deck of the Guy West Bridge. During construction a protected pedestrian walkway will be provided to provide access through the construction area.

On December 6, 1988, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on January 31, 1989. The bids received were:

D.W. Nicholson Corporation	\$ 61,098
Christie Contractors, Inc.	\$ 72,160
Rigging International	\$152,754
Applegate & Reidy, Inc.	\$153,320
Adams & Smith, Inc.	\$171,840

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$250,000. The estimated project completion date is September 1, 1989.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$147,000. The current budget is \$317,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Transportation Development Funds (235). The funds available for this project amount to \$253,000, as of January 31, 1989.

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POLICY CONSIDERATIONS


There are no policy considerations associated with this item.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS


Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE construction organizations. There were twenty-one (21) plan holders for this project and the City received five (5) bids. One of the bidders appears to be a WBE, but has not been certified.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of D.W. Nicholson Corporation in the amount of \$61,098, and award the contract.
