SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on November 5, 1991.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project is a portion of the overall project for closure of the City Landfill and consists of grading and lining approximately 600 lineal feet of existing drainage channel for the outfall to the American River.

This project will be advertised for bids using two alternatives with the cost being a factor in the determination of the alternative to be chosen. Bidders will be required to bid on both alternatives. The engineer's estimated construction cost for Alternative A is \$173,500 and for Alternative B, \$86,200.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$190,900 for Alternative A and \$94,800 for Alternative B. The current budget for the closure of the landfill is \$4,766,660, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program with \$1,168,115 from Solid Waste funds (415) and \$3,598,545 from Landfill Closure funds (253). The funds available for this portion of the overall closure project amount to approximately \$1,676,000, as of September 24, 1991.

A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.301 of the City Code concerning advertisement for bids.

Plans and specifications will be sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with the MBE/WBE contractors.


