SUBJECT: Grant Application to the Area 4 Agency on Aging for Older American Act Title III Funding for the Senior Companion Program (Homebound Component) and Golden Era Handicrafts.

SUMMARY

Attached is a resolution approving submission of a continuation application to the Area 4 Agency on Aging and authorizing the Interim Executive Director to execute a contract for such funds upon receipt. The request for the Interim Executive Director to execute the contract is subject to the premise that the application is approved as requested.

BACKGROUND

The Senior Companion Program has been partially funded by the Area 4 Agency on Aging since 1978. The purpose of this funding is to enable 10 low-income older persons serving in the Homebound Component to remain active and productive in the community while providing a total of 10,400 hours of service to 50+ frail and at-risk older persons residing in private homes.

The Golden Era Handicrafts project provides opportunities for 700+ elderly artisans from Sacramento and six neighboring counties to market their home-crafted items at the storefront in Old Sacramento.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total request is for \$49,274 for the Senior Companion Program which constitutes an increase of \$3,942 from the 1980-81 budget. This amounts to 11% of the total Foster Grandparent/Senior Companion Program budget. The request for Golden Era Handicrafts is \$14,262, an increase of \$1,141 over the previous year. There are no new staff positions in either proposal. The attachment includes the budgets for Golden Era Handicrafts, Senior Companion Program, and the total Title III funding for the combined programs. The grant award will become available mid June.
