RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING MARGARET ANN MANCINA

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Margaret Ann Mancina on the fourth day of April, at the age of 66, in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Margaret Mancina was a well-known and respected member of the Sacramento community whose exemplary efforts and accomplishments were of great value to the citizens and the City of Sacramento; and,

WHEREAS, Margaret Mancina's outstanding public service career included affiliation with the Mercy Hospital Guild, the Sutter Hospital Guild, the Sacramento Symphony League, Christ Unity Church, League of Women Voters, American Association of University Women, La Causerie Francaise, and Casa de los Ninos at the Sacramento Children's Home
