## RECOGNIZING THOM'S CYCLERY

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Sacramento that we hereby join the Cabinet in extending its deep appreciation to Thom's Cyclery for its longstanding contributions to the local retail economy and do hereby commend Verland Thom and his family for their commitment and efforts as a major partner in our City's neighborhood economic development activities in Oak Park.
