SUBJECT: Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission/Acceptance of
\$20,000 from Friends of the Arts Commission

SUMMARY

This report recommends acceptance of \$20,000 from Friends of the Arts Commission, provided by Target Stores, for the second annual Sacramento Children's Festival. This festival is produced by the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Friends of the Arts Commission is the non-profit fundraising arm of the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Division. On April 4, 1991, Target Stores presented Friends of the Arts Commission \$20,000 for the 1991 Sacramento Children's Festival.

The Children's Festival will take place on June 1st in Old Sacramento and Downtown Plaza Mall with over ten performance areas. Target stores is sponsoring the Main Stage area featuring national, regional, and local-based artistic talent. Scheduled to appear are: Annie Hickman of the Muppets performing "Love Bug's Hug" with companion Allynn Goen; Harambee, Pan-African Dance Ensemble; the California Cajun Orchestra; Friends in High Places, a ballroom stilt dancing duo, and many others.

FINANCIAL DATA

An increase in appropriations of \$20,000 to the FY1990-91 operating grant fund is necessary to process payments related to the Sacramento Children's Festival - Main Stage area.




