SUBJECT: Rejection of Bids for Tree Trimming for Clearance of Fire Alarm
Aerial Wires

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and staff recommends that the bids be rejected and the project readvertised for bids at a later date.

BACKGROUND:

On March 23, 1982 the City Council approved plans and specifications for Tree Trimming for Clearance of Fire Alarm Aerial Wires and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on April 13, 1982. The bids received are as follows:

Oakley Tree Service	\$20,400.00
Weavers Tree Service	24,980.00

The engineer's estimate was \$17,160.00.

FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1981/82 the City Council approved \$17,160.00 in the Fire Alarm Activity Budget for the subject project. Since the low bid of Oakley Tree Service is 18% above the amount budgeted, staff feels it is in the best interest of the City to reject all bids and readvertise the project at a later date.

It is recommended that the bids be rejected and the project readvertised for bids at a later date.
