SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit for Installing a Book Return Unit for the California State Library located on N Street between 9th and 10th Streets

SUMMARY

The State of California has applied for a Revocable Encroachment Permit for the purpose of installing a book return unit for the California State Library in the City of Sacramento public right-of-way.

The Director of Public Works recommends that the Permit be granted.

BACKGROUND

This encroachment permit is being requested for excavation work to be done in the area of N Street between 9th and 10th Streets. The applicant is requesting the permit for the book return unit to be in compliance with the Sacramento City Code, Chapter 12, Section 12.70

FINANCIAL DATA

POLICY CONSIDERATION

Sacramento City Code, Chapter 12, Section 12.70 states that Council may by resolution grant permits revocable at its will for minor or temporary purposes or privileges on public property subject to such terms and conditions as it deems necessary for the public interest. The use of the property by the permittee shall constitute his acceptance and agreement to be bound by the terms and conditions of the permit. Issuance of this permit is consistent with this policy.



RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR BOOK RETURN UNIT FOR CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY LOCATED ON N STREET BETWEEN 9TH AND 10TH STREETS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit be granted to State of California for the purpose of installing a book return unit.

This encroachment is described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the right of way, of the northeast corner of N Street and 9th Street; thence easterly 106.00 feet; thence southerly 10.75 feet.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit," which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management and Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.



To Whom It May Concern:

The State of California has elected to be insured for its motor vehicle and general liability exposures through a self-insurance program. The State Attorney General administers the general liability program through an annual appropriation from the General Fund. The Office of Insurance and Risk Management administers the motor vehicle liability program.

Under this form of insurance, the State and its employees (as defined in Section 810.2 of the Government Code) are insured for any tort liability that may develop through carrying out official activities, including state official operations on non-state owned property. Should any claims arise by reason of such operations or under an official contract or license agreement, they should be referred to the Attorney General, State of California, Tort Liability Section, 1515 K Street, Suite 511, Sacramento, CA 95814.

The State of California has entered into a Master Agreement with the State Compensation Insurance Fund to administer workers' compensation benefits for all state employees, as required by the Labor Code.
