

ORDINANCE NO. 396, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO DO THE WORK OF REMOVING FOUR THOUSAND (4000) CUBIC YARDS, MORE OR LESS, OF EARTH AT THE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to remove four thousand (4000) cubic yards, more or less, of earth from the knoll at the north end of the main runway at the Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity to have this removed at a nominal price, to-wit: Fifteen (\$.15) cents per cubic yard, by a contractor who desires the earth for a fill on the Auburn Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the contractor must have the earth immediately, if at all; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended to the City Council that it would be to the advantage of the City to have said earth so removed,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: It is hereby directed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that four thousand (4000) cubic yards, more or less, of earth, from the knoll at the north end of the main runway be removed by the City without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such

emergency being the necessity of immediately removing the earth in order to obtain the advantage of a nominal figure per cubic yard for said removal, and shall take effect immediately.
