SUBJECT: Agreement to Purchase Imported Borrow

SUMMARY:

It is requested the City enter into the attached agreement with J. E. McAmis, Inc., Chico, California, to purchase 22,400 cubic yards of imported borrow at a unit price of \$5.40 per cubic yard for a total of \$120,960. This material would be used to meet the City's commitment of providing the Corps of Engineers that volume of material for repairs to the American River levee.

BACKGROUND:

The Corps of Engineers has let a contract to repair the American River levee caused by the February high water near the Business I-80 freeway crossing on the south bank of the river. The City had made a commitment to provide the Corps of Engineers with 22,400 cubic yards of material from the landfill. Ultimately this material would have to be replaced in the landfill.

J. E. McAmis, Inc. was awarded the Corps of Engineers American River levee repair contract as well as the City's Sacramento Boat Harbor Expansion - Contract 1 project.

The low bid price to haul 400,000 cubic yards import to the City landfill by McAmis under the Boat Harbor contract was \$6.13 per cubic yard. McAmis agrees to haul an additional 22,400 cubic yards to be incorporated in the Corps of Engineers levee project for \$5.40 per cubic yard. This price includes the economies the contractor sees in not having to double handle the material at the landfill and in being able to coordinate a direct haul to the levee work.

The City Council is requested to waive the competitive bidding requirements for the subject agreement because of the above stated economies between the Boat Harbor's contract unit price and the proposed agreement price which is 14% lower.

FINANCIAL


The cost of the 22,400 cubic yards of imported borrow is \$121,960. This agreement covers the imported borrow materials to be used in the "Reconstruct Levee South Side American River" (425-500-WA96-4820) CIP Project listed in the approved 1986-87 CIP Budget. There is approximately \$440,000 available for this project.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the City Council:


1. Waive the competitive bidding requirement for the subject agreement.


