SUBJECT: Landscape Development of Interstate 5 Scenic Corridor (PN:LC16) - Resolution  
Approving Negative Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse affect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the Landscape Development of Interstate 5 Scenic Corridor (PN:LC16) would not have a significant adverse affect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On September 19, 1988, the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On September 22, 1988, Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

The Interstate 5 scenic corridor will be landscaped in accordance with the agreement between the City and the developers of the adjacent property.

4. Authorize the Environmental Coordinator to file a Notice of Determination with the County Clerk.


