SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - Vandenberg Motors

SUMMARY:

Vandenberg Motors has applied for a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing canvass awnings on the east side of Alhambra Boulevard, between "K" Street and "L" Street. The City Engineer recommends that the permit be granted.

BACKGROUND:

The area for which this request is being made consists of an area approximately 16' X 3' 6" on the east side of Alhambra Boulevard between "K" Street and "L" Street. The area is adjacent to the cylindrical portion of the existing building. This awning is needed to provide protection to the show-room windows.

RECOMMENDATION:

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of
Constructing Canvass Awnings

is hereby granted to VANDENBERG MOTORS, whose

The encroachment area is described as follows:

An area approximately 16' X 3' 6" on the East side of Alhambra Boulevard, between
"K" Street and "L" Street. The area is adjacent to the cylindrical portion of the
existing building.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions -
Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council
in Resolution No. 77-611 dated October 4, 1977, and the hereinafter
specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only
after the applicant files with the Department of Finance of the City of
Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The permittee shall comply with all requirements of the City Planning Department,
the City Building Inspection Division, and the City Sign Ordinance.
2. The awnings shall be at least eight feet (8') above any portion of the Public
Sidewalk.
