SUBJECT: Emergency Contract to Repair Drainage Sump 94

SUMMARY

Emergency repairs are underway at the subject drainage sump in order to prevent potential flooding of adjacent subdivisions. The sump is located on Reichmuth Way and is located adjacent to the west side of I-5, approximately one quarter mile north of Florin Road.

BACKGROUND

On approximately February 15, 1986 a section of 30" diameter corrugated metal pipe that leads from Reichmuth Way to the pump station collapsed, along with a section of the adjacent street. The incident resulted in the two pumps located at the pump station site being shut down because of the silt and gravel that entered into the sump from the resulting erosion. The pumps are currently being repaired by the Water and Sewer Division and should be in service shortly. Flooding of streets and houses is a continuing threat until the drainage station is restored to service. An emergency contract of approximately \$100,000 with Teichert Construction Company is being negotiated to repair the drain line entering the pump station site. Work is currently underway and should be completed in the near future.

FINANCIAL

Necessary project funds are being transferred from various existing cost centers with the Public Works Department CIP Program to pay for the emergency repair work which is estimated to cost approximately \$100,000.

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RECOMMENDATION




