SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID, AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO M & M ELECTRIC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$207,777 AND APPROVAL OF PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT FOR FLORIN ROAD STREET LIGHTING PROJECT (PN: SO01)

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

The Florin Road Street Lighting Project (PN: SO01) is located on Florin Road between Tamoshanter Drive and Franklin Boulevard. Council District No. 8.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve plans and specifications;
- Accept the low bid of M&M Electric in the amount of \$207,777;
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for Florin Road Street Lighting Project (PN: SO01); and
- Adopt the attached resolution approving Program Supplement No. 068-M and appropriates \$257,393 in Transportation Enhancement Activities (TEA) funds to the Florin Road Street Lighting Project (PN: SO01).

SUMMARY:

This project will improve the street lighting of all the businesses along Florin Road between Tamoshanter Drive and Franklin Boulevard. The purpose of the project is to improve pedestrian and vehicle safety and encourage revitalization of an older commercial corridor.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- This project was authorized in the 1999/2000 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on May 9, 2001 and are summarized below:

- The construction estimate was \$210,000.
- Approval of the plans and specifications and award to M&M Electric is recommended.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- The Florin Road Street Lighting Project has insufficient funds to award the contract, however, with the following transaction there will be sufficient funds to award the contract:
 - Funding appropriations of \$257,393 will be made from federal funds in accordance with Program Supplement No. 068-M.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The City of Sacramento is the lead agency for CEQA and NEPA compliance. It was determined that a categorical exemption (CEQA) is adequate for this project under CEQA Section Number 15301.

Because the project is being partially financed with federal transportation funds, a Categorical Exclusion was prepared to satisfy the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

This action requested herein is consistent with the Sacramento City Code, Title 3.

All are directly involved with ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. Project notices were sent to 30 organizations involved in ESBE recruitment. The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at www.cityofsacramento.org/bids.



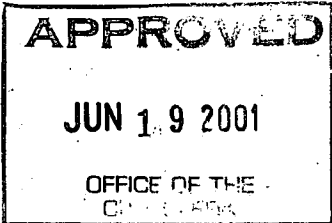

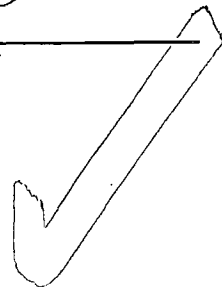

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO
ORDER IMPROVEMENTS FOR FY
2001/02 FOR NORTHSIDE
SUBDIVISION MAINTENANCE

1. The City Council intends to levy and collect assessments within the Northside Subdivision Maintenance District during fiscal year 2001/02. The area of land to be assessed is located in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

2. The maintenance of improvements to be made in this assessment district is generally described as follows:

Wetlands: The work to be performed consists of the special monitoring, maintenance and repair of the designated wetland areas as identified in the Corps of Engineers Nationwide Permit, issued on June 12, 1990, for Northside Subdivision (hereafter referred to as "Corps Permit"). Specifically, the work may include, but not be limited to, monitoring and maintenance of seasonal wetlands, inspection and minor repairs to basin inlets and outlets, mowing fire breaks, litter control and patrolling, road maintenance, minor bank repairs, inspection and maintenance of oil/sand interceptors, keeping of contractor's records, and any related work necessary to comply with the conditions of said Corps Permit. Pumping, hauling and disposal of collected wastes shall be in accordance with all appropriate state, federal and local regulations. The work does not include general maintenance of the drainage channel as normally provided by the City of Sacramento.

Landscaping and Masonry Wall: The work to be performed consists of furnishing all tools, equipment, apparatus, facilities, labor, material, supplies and utilities necessary or desirable to maintain the masonry walls, landscaping and irrigation systems. Maintenance work may include, but not be limited to, periodic mowing of grass, trimming of trees and shrubs, and fertilizing, together with regular furnishing of water for irrigation of all irrigation of all plant material, and the repair, maintenance and replacement of the irrigation system, planted materials and amenities. Certain types of the unscheduled maintenance may also be performed, but only when specifically authorized by the City of Sacramento. These tasks include plant replacement, turf and grassland seeding, insect, weed and rodent control, erosion control, maintaining/repairing masonry walls, channel repairs, hauling and dumping debris, maintaining floodway improvements, maintaining areas adjacent to the floodway right-of-way, and repair of damage due to vandalism, flood or fire.

3. In accordance with this Council's resolution directing the filing of any Annual Report, the Engineer of Work has filed with the City Clerk the report required by Chapter 3.124, Sacramento City Code. All interested persons are referred to that report for a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the assessment district, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the assessment district.

4. On Tuesday, the 19th day of June 2001 at the hour of 2 p.m. the City Council will conduct a public hearing on

the proposed annual assessment. The hearing will be held at the meeting place of the City Council located in City Hall, 915 I Street, 2nd Floor, Sacramento, California.

5. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to give the notice of hearing required by Chapter 3.124 of the Sacramento City Code.


