SUBJECT: Request for Time Extension for Glenwood Park Unit 8 (P-8603)

LOCATION: Northwest corner of Bell Avenue and Austin Street

SUMMARY

The subject tentative map was approved by the City Council on July 17, 1979 and lapsed January 17, 1981. The applicant is seeking a 12-month time extension in order to secure construction financing and complete the final map.

The subdivision consists of 51 single family residential lots on $10\pm$ acres. North/south unit orientation is 84 percent, well within current policy guidelines.

RECOMMENDATION

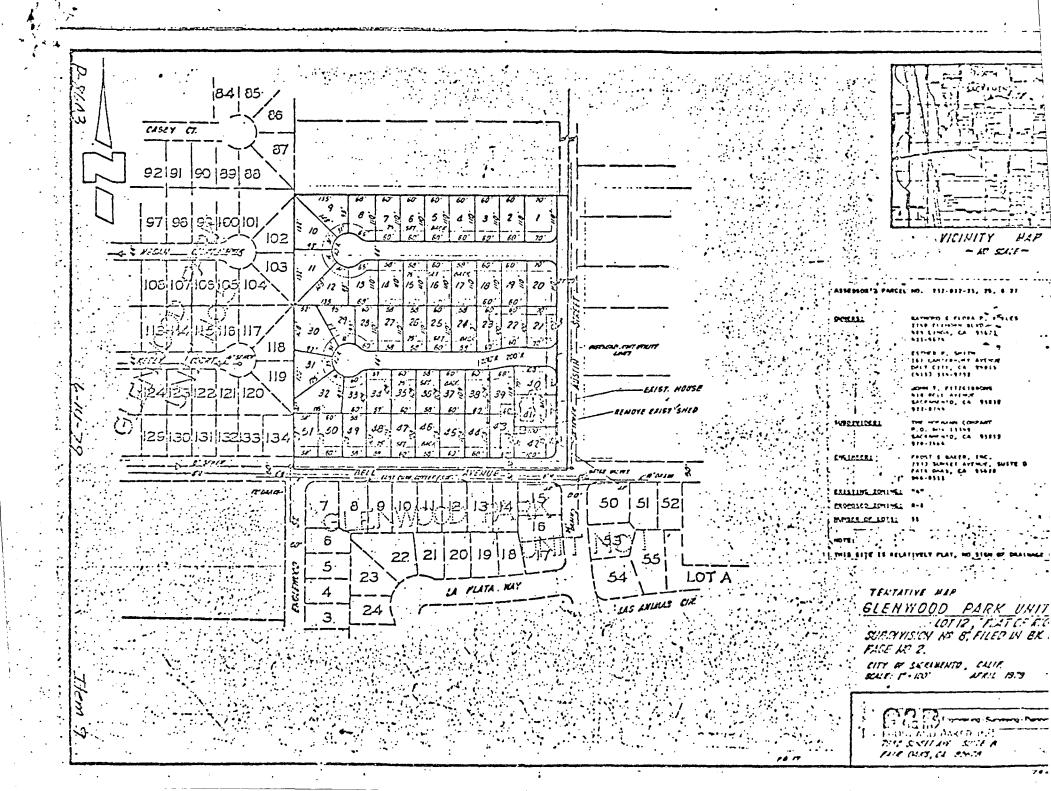
Staff recommends that the City Council grant a one-time, one-year time extension for the tentative map. Said extension shall lapse on January 17, 1982.

ADOPTING FINDINGS OF FACT, APPROVING A REQUEST FOR TENTATIVE MAP TO DIVICE 10+ ACRES, INTO 51 RESILENTIAL LOTS, LOCATED ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF BELL AVENUE AND AUSTIN STREET TO BE KNOWN AS GLENWOOD PARK UNIT NO. 8.

(APN: 237-022-25, 26, 27) (P-8603)

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has submitted to the City Council its report and recommendations concerning the request for a tentative map for property located on the N.E. corner of Bell Avenue and Austin Street to be known as Glenwood Park Unit No. 8 (hereinafter referred to as the proposed subdivision).

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Sacramento, based on testimony submitted at a public hearing conducted on July 17, 1979 hereby finds and determines as follows:

- A. The proposed subdivision, together with the provisions for its design and improvement, is consistent with the City General Plan and the North Norwood Community Plan in that both plans designated the subject site for residential uses. Also, any required improvements are to be designed and constructed within the provisions of the Subdivision Regulations which, by Section 40.102 of said regulations, is designated as a Specific Plan of the City of Sacramento.
- B. The site is physically suitable for the type and proposed density of development in that the subject site is flat with no significant erosional, soil expansion or other similar problems.
- C. The design of the subdivision or proposed improvements are not likely to cause substantial environmental damage, and will not substantially and avoidably injure fish or wildlife or their habitat. The proposed project has been reviewed and assessed by the Environmental Coordinator, who has filed a Negative Declaration with the City Clerk. By virtue of the Negative Declaration, the proposed project will not cause individual or cumulative adverse effects on the natural and social-physical environment nor substantially and avoidably injure fish, wildlife or their habitat.
- D. The design of the subdivision or the type of improvements are not likely to cause serious public health problems in that community water and sewer systems exist at the site. The site is not within an established floodplain or over a known seismic fault.
- E. The design of the subdivision or the type of improvements will not conflict with easements acquired by the public for access through, or use of, the property within the proposed subdivision, in that there are no access easements for use by the public at large on the subject site.
- r. The discharge of waste from the proposed subdivision into the community sewer system servicing the proposed subdivision will not result in or add to a violation of the waste discharge requirements applicable to said sewer system which were prescribed by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, in that the existing City of Sacramento treatment plants have a design capacity of 75 mgd and that actual treated discharge averages 56 mgd. The discharge from the proposed project will not create a condition exceeding the design capacity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Sacramento, as follows:

- A. The Negative Declaration be ratified;
- B. The Tentative Map be approved subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. Applicant shall prepare a sewer and drainage study for review and approved by the City Engineer.
 - 2. Applicant shall provide the standard improvements as required by the Subdivision Ordinance (Section 40.811).
 - 3. Applicant shall pay off any existing assessments prior to filing the final map.
 - 4. Applicant shall provide street lights as required by the Subdivision Ordinance (Section 40.811).
 - 5. Along Austin Street, applicant shall provide 27' half street improvements and a 12' lane and 3' shoulder for east side, subject to the review of the Traffic Engineer.
 - 6. Applicant shall align Austin Street with the existing intersection of Austin Street on the south side of Bell Avenue to the satisfaction of the Traffic Engineer (may require off-site dedication and improvements).
 - 7. Applicant shall redesign the southern cul-de-sac with a 300' radius.

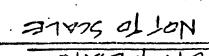

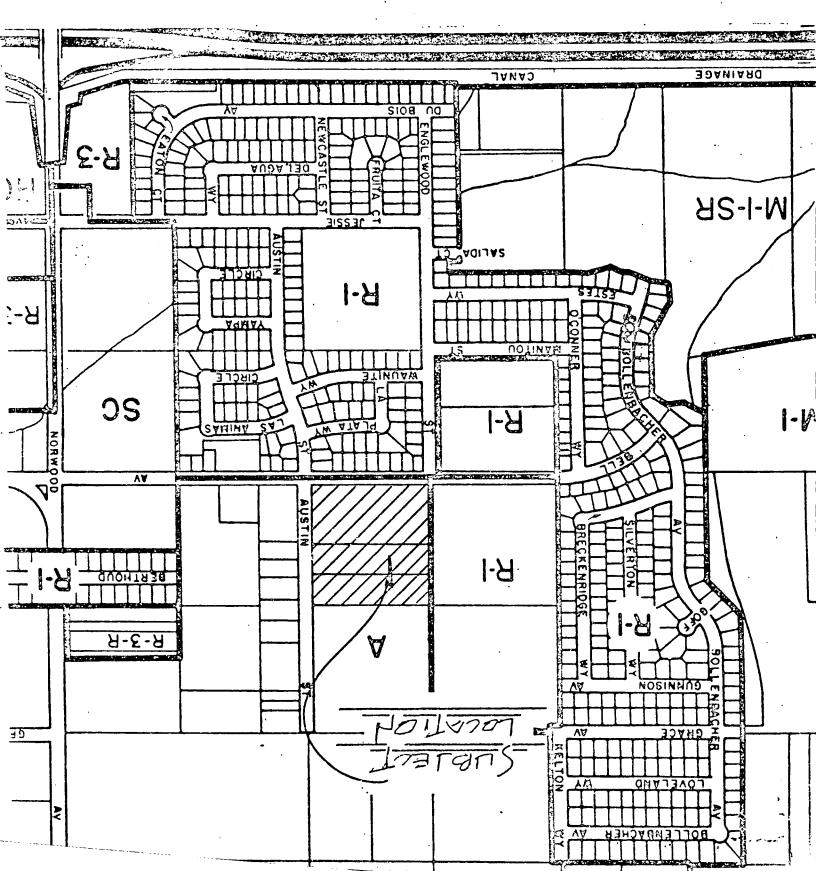
