## **RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING AILEEN WILSON**

**IT IS HEREBY NOTED** that the people of the City of Sacramento suffered a great loss in the passing of Aileen "Kit" Wilson on the 13th Day of December, 1986 at the age of 50, in Sacramento, California.

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Wilson served the City of Sacramento for 14 years as a Supervising Identification Technician with the Police Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Wilson, in 1979, received widespread acclaim for her tireless efforts to positively identify the "Downtown Rapist," believed responsible for 22 assaults; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Wilson volunteered actively in the Sacramento community, particularly with the Police Department's "Thumbs Up" program to fingerprint school children, and the Police Athletic League; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Council wishes to publicly recognize the contributions of Mrs. "Kit" Wilson to our community and in so doing expresses its condolences to her family and friends;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Mrs. "Kit" Wilson;
