ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING
VELMA WYATT UNGER**

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Velma Wyatt Unger on the thirty-first day of January, 1983, in Sacramento.

WHEREAS, Velma Wyatt Unger was a native of Winters and a 55-year resident of Sacramento who was very active in Sacramento church and civic affairs; and,

WHEREAS, Mrs. Unger performed many valuable services for the people of this State, both through her nursing career and through her voluntary work with the Tuesday Club, the Visiting Nurses Association, the Women's Fellowship of the First Christian Church, and the P.E.O. Sisterhood; and,

WHEREAS, she and her husband, Charles F. Unger raised a fine family and built up the Unger Construction Co. in Sacramento, both of which are thriving today; and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Velma Wyatt Unger, and so has caused this Resolution to be prepared;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Velma Wyatt Unger;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to Mrs. Unger's sons, Dean and Wyatt, and the entire Unger family.
